Thereafter, in the meeting of Committee of Secretaries (CoS) held on 20.08.2018 six sub committees comprising group of Ministries/Departments were constituted. Activities were assigned to each sub committee to be undertaken in a time bound manner.

Cabinet Secretary is likely to review the progress made in this regard shortly. It is therefore requested that activities taken up so far and proposed to be taken up to December, 2019 by your Ministry/Department may be sent to the Ministry of Culture by 25.04.2019. Government of India is commemorating 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi for a period of two years from 2nd October, 2018 to 2nd October, 2020 at National and International level. There will be a number of commemorative and constructive activities to be taken up by Government of India as well as State Governments. Ministry of Culture is the nodal agency for coordinating all activities.

2. The National Committee meeting headed by Hon'ble President of India was held on 2.5.2018 and Executive Committee Meeting headed by Hon'ble Prime Minister was held on 18.7.2018 respectively. Suggestions received in these meetings have been shared with concerned Ministries for implementation.

3. A list of suggested activities is enclosed for your kind consideration. This list is only indicative. One of the activities suggested is that all tableaux for Republic Day Parade 2019 to be Gandhi themed. Each Ministry / Department may take up additional activities at their end. The commemorative activities will continue for a period of 2 years. However, at present, Ministries may draw one year action plan beginning from October, 2018 to October, 2019.

4. It is requested that all commemorative programmes may be turned into people's programmes by motivating people at all levels. All activities taken up by the Ministries / Departments under the commemoration may also be uploaded on the web portal being hosted by Ministry of Culture.

List of approved activities planned for commemoration of 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

1. Competition of Play on Gandhi-Plays to be organised by schools and colleges across the country. The best team to perform during the International Convention (September 29 – October 2, 2018).
2. Gandhi to be the theme for all activities planned for Republic Day Parade on 26 Jan 2019 including Tableau by various Ministries and states.
3. Special remission to convicts on October 02, 2018, April 06, 2019 and October 02, 2019. Many State Governments have already identified convicts to be released.
4. Video of *Vajshnava Jana** sung by the prominent singers and celebrities of the country shot at iconic places to be created and screened during the commemoration period. Similarly, another video to be created involving singers of other countries at iconic places of their country. The tune and lyrics of the song to be kept intact and original. Videos have been received from about 100 Missions.
5. Short film competition on Gandhi to be organised by NFDC in collaboration with MyGov. themed at 'Be the change which you want to be in the world'. Submission of entries to start from 2nd October to 31st December.
6. Pada Yatra to be organised by Nehru Yuva Kendra involving 150 youth at a time walking for 10 kms per day for 150 days covering every village of the country. Similarly, Cycle Yatra also to be organised. During these yatras, awareness to be generated about Gandhi's teachings, drug abuse and other local social evils like dowry, female foeticide etc.
7. Efforts to be made to create World record in cycling event across the globe on a single day.
8. Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) is organising relay cycle yatra (Lauh Yatra) from 16th October, 2018 to 27th January, 2019— 1,50,000 cyclists covering 18,000 kms
9. 150 youth/students of one state to visit a partner state under Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat. Camps to be organised for 150 students/youth (5 from each state) for staying together for some time
10. 150 major Universities of India to tie up with 150 International Universities and organise conferences on Gandhi and bring out compendium.
